## How does it work?

### Step 1

It's simple! Students go to the Sw@nline website [www.swanline.wa.edu.au](http://www.swanline.wa.edu.au) and log on, using the username and password that has been issued to them.

### Step 2

The Sw@nline home page gives students easy access to all their subjects just by a click of their mouse.

### Step 3

Each subject is divided into weeks in which students can see their lessons, assignments and instructions from their tutor.

### Step 4

Every student and one parent is given their own [scea.wa.edu.au](mailto:scea.wa.edu.au) email address. We provide clear instructions on how to access your email.

## Future subjects

## What fees are involved?

### Discount

Families that enrol in more than four subjects per academic year receive a 10% discount on each additional subject.

### Payment

The first quarter fees must be paid up front to ensure a place on the course. Fees are paid up front for each quarter of the year.

### Additional costs and charges

Successfully enrolled applicants will need to provide their own computer (preferably broadband equipped) and subscribe to digital library access with Sw@nline.
